Holidays booked in term time will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. **Parents are reminded that the authorisation of all absences is at the discretion of the Headteacher** and the Headteacher's permission must be sought before taking children out of school during term time. We would also ask that any routine medical appointments are, where possible, arranged outside the school day.

## Notes

### Arrival and collection arrangements

Parents are reminded that the school day begins with registration at 8.50am. Children may arrive at school from 8.30am. On wet mornings children should go straight to their classrooms. Staff are not on duty before 8.30am and children should not be left without parental supervision on the school site before this time.

The school day ends at 3.15pm and children must be collected promptly. Infant teachers take their classes to the door to meet their parents and Junior teachers lead their classes into the playground to be met at an agreed place. If parents are unavoidably delayed in picking up children we ask that you telephone the school office as soon as possible so a message can be passed to your children and their teacher.

**Parents collecting children after 3.25pm, due to a delay, must sign them out in the 'late pick up book' at the School Office.**

### Class Assemblies

Parents are warmly invited to join us for class assemblies. Children involved in class assemblies do not wear school uniform on the day of their class assembly.

### Extreme Weather

In the event of snow Years 1-6 should come into school down the green lane **at the start of the school day**. Parents are asked not to accompany their children. Nursery and Reception children should be left with staff at the Nursery gate. If it is not possible for parents to access the site **at the end of the school day**, bright orange signs will be fastened to the fence at the front of the school. Parents are asked to wait in the designated waiting areas until they are called to collect their children. The youngest children will be dismissed first.
